

Tracking Out-of-Pocket Expenses



An out-of-pocket expense counts towards the maximum dollar amount that a covered person must pay during a defined benefit period.

How can I track my out-of-pocket expenses?

Based on your plan, you will see a box on the **express-scripts.com*** home page after you log in, showing your current remaining plan balances, including out of pocket (see right).

View more information by clicking “**View Details of Your Balances**” or by selecting “**View Rx History & Balances**” from the menu under **Manage Prescriptions**.


On the **Claims & Balances** page, click “view details” next to **Out of Pocket** (see below). This will change the view to display your out-of-pocket expense details to date.
